



## Conditions for Admission to the on-site Events of the 6<sup>th</sup> International Hybrid Power Systems Workshop in Madeira, Portugal from 26 – 27 April 2022

The organizer adheres to the [regulations of Madeira, Portugal](#) valid at the time of the event. Only symptom-free persons, who are not under quarantine and who can prove that they belong to one of the groups defined below will be admitted to the conference venue.

### In short, all registered participants need to:

- ✓ Download and set up the Portuguese [STAYWAY App](#) prior to the event to be used for contact tracing
- ✓ Wear their FFP2 mask
- ✓ Prove that they belong to one of the four groups listed below



These conditions of admission refer to the regulations of Madeira valid as of 14 April 2022. Please check this file just prior to the event for updated instructions.

1) **Vaccinated persons** must show their vaccination card or a similar document showing that the second vaccination was at least 14 days ago and at most 270 days ago. You can also show your digital vaccination certificate instead. Vaccination means: the second dose must also have been administered if two doses are scheduled for a vaccine (e.g., BioNTech/Pfizer, Moderna and AstraZeneca). Only a vaccine that is accepted in Madeira, Portugal is allowed as proof: [BioNTech/Pfizer](#), [Moderna](#), [AstraZeneca](#), [Janssen Pharmaceutica NV](#) (Johnson & Johnson), Sinovac/Instituto Buntantan, Instituto Gambaleya (Sputnik V) and Sinopharm (VeroCell).

2) **Tested persons** must present a negative rapid test result at the first day of the conference. The test must have been taken no longer than 24 hours ago. The result must be confirmed in writing or digitally by an official testing center. An overview of test centers can be found [here](#). In addition, an official identification document must be carried. The organizer does not accept or offer self-tests on site.

3) **Recovered persons** must have a positive PCR test result. The test must be at least 28 days old and no more than 90 days old. However, after 90 days have passed, the convalescent status expires, meaning they will need a negative test result or vaccination again from that point on.

4) **Recovered vaccinated persons** are considered fully vaccinated after the first vaccination. As proof, they need a positive PCR test result, which must be at least 28 days old, but may also be not older than 90 days. They also need a vaccination card or similar document showing that they were vaccinated once, more than two weeks ago.

**Individuals at higher risk for severe COVID-19 disease** are advised not to attend the event, especially unless they have full vaccination protection. (<https://www.ecdc.europa.eu/en/covid-19/high-risk-groups>).
